Pertussis Cluster in West Auckland

Important Message for Health Providers - call for vigilance

In the last week ARPHS has received an increase in pertussis notifications in West Auckland including a small cluster in Laingholm and Henderson. There has not been a corresponding sustained rise in pertussis notifications across the whole Auckland region.

We request General Practices are vigilant regarding the following:

- 1. Consider pertussis in patients with paroxysmal cough and especially those children attending local primary schools or early childhood centres.
- 2. Take a nasopharyngeal swab for pertussis PCR (if coughing < 3 weeks and not already linked to another case)
- 3. Exclude cases from school, work, other institution, and social interaction while waiting for the laboratory results.
- 4. **Notify** ARPHS (09) 6234600 **on suspicion**
- 5. **Treat** confirmed cases with azithromycin
- 6. Identify vulnerable contacts and provide azithromycin chemoprophylaxis
- 7. <u>Discuss</u> pertussis immunisation with parents and pregnant women. Immunisation offers the best protection from pertussis.

Pertussis is highly infectious and a potentially serious illness especially in the young. Around 70% of infants under one year of age with pertussis require hospitalisation.
